Marx loved sprawl

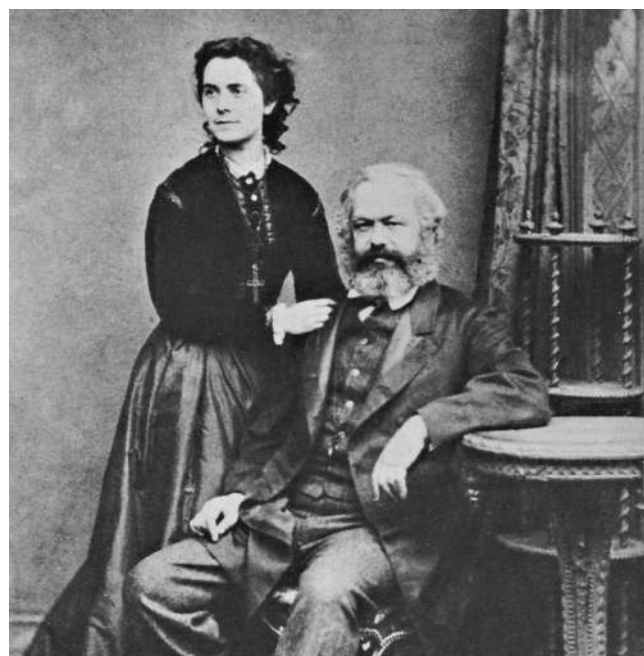
Not all the ideas of 1960's college professors' hero seems to have found a home.
